

COUNTRY SHORE, INC. – CAMPGROUND RULES

1. **PETS - ONLY ONE PET PER SITE. NO VISITING PETS.** Pets must be on a leash not greater than six feet. Campers must clean up after pets **on and off** the site. **Only people able to clean up after pets shall be allowed to walk the pet throughout the campground.** Pets are not allowed on beach or in campground buildings. New Hampshire Law requires that you exhibit proof that your pet has had a rabies shot. A barking and/or vicious dog must be removed from the camping area.
2. **RUBBISH** - Only every day bagged household trash can be put into the dumpster. Some restrictions are: tires, batteries, pallets, furniture, mattresses, appliances, wood, oil, gas tanks, dangerous chemicals, etc.
3. **CAMPsites** - Only one camping unit along with a tent and a commercially made screened enclosure is allowed per site. **Vertical wood structures are not permitted.** Platforms must be made in sections no larger than 4' X 8'. **Particle board and pallets are not allowed.** Size and location of platforms must be approved prior to construction. **NO pole type Garages.** Do not change the location of the fireplace without permission because of electrical and water lines. Campfires must be small, attended, and confined to your fireplace. Please completely extinguish all fires before retiring or before 11:00pm. Water hose must be available at campfire. No burning of leaves. One small clothes line is permitted for beach apparel.
4. **BOATS** - Boat docks are for seasonal campers only. Seasonal campers must be present in boat when boat is being used. Power boats must be properly licensed in NH and must have the state-required safety equipment. **Absolutely** no one on boat dock unless accompanied by a boat owner. No boats are allowed in or near the swimming area. No moorings allowed. Visitors are not allowed to bring boats. Dock space fee must be paid, and space assigned before launching boats.
5. **CAMPING AREA APPEARANCE** - We expect sites to be kept as natural as possible and in a neat and orderly condition. Campers shall wash their trailer at least once per season. Please do not cut, mutilate or transplant any tree, shrub, bush, etc. Please do not litter - use provided cigarette butt receptacles and trash cans. **After initial spring clean up absolutely no blowing or raking leaves or other debris into the roadway. They must be bagged for pickup.**
6. **USE OF THE SITE BY OTHER PARTIES** - Loan or use of your campsite by others is not permitted **unless** prearrangement is made with the office and the daily site rental fee is collected.

7. **PARKING - All visitors must park in the parking lot.** You are allowed one camper owned vehicle at your site. Permission for a second camper owned vehicle may be given by the owners if the campsite allows. Two (2) cars maximum per site. Parking on roads, on leach fields, in woods or any other area other than parking lot is not permitted. No parking on other people's campsites with or without permission from them. Every vehicle needs a valid Camping or Visitors pass. Any vehicle without a pass will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
8. **CURFEW** - Absolutely no unnecessary noise between the hours of 11 p.m. and 9 a.m. Children 12 and under must be on their own campsite by 9 p.m., unless accompanied by an adult. Children under 18 must be on a campsite by 10:30 p.m. and on their own site by 11:00 p.m. Absolutely no one, regardless of age, should be roaming the campground after 11:00 pm.
9. **SHOWERS and RESTROOMS** - Please help us to keep your restroom clean. When young children are using the bathrooms or showers, they should be accompanied by an adult. No loitering in or near the restrooms.

10. **SAFETY** - Swim at your own risk - a lifeguard is not provided. Children and poor swimmers must be accompanied by an adult. Parents are responsible for the behavior and safety of their children in the water and on the campground. Children are not allowed at campground unattended. No glass bottles or cups, pets, or bikes are allowed on the beach. Smokers are asked to please dispose of cigarette butts and trash in appropriate containers. Please clean up after yourself. No swimming after dark. No bike riding after dark. No bike riding on the paved road around the office or leading to the campground entrance. Please use the path to get to the field.
11. **PROPERTY DAMAGE and BEHAVIOR** - Use or possession of illegal drugs, Use of foul language, any obscenity or anyone creating a disturbance and/or abusing camping area property or other camper's property is not permitted.
12. **SPEED LIMIT** - Speed limit on roads is 5 m.p.h.
13. **OTHER CAMPSITES** - Please do not cut through other people's campsites. Use the roads and paths provided.
14. **VISITORS** - You are responsible for making sure your visitors are registered in the office and that are aware of campground rules. **Visitors must register and pay at the office (or house) and park in the parking lot before going to your site.** All day visitors shall leave the campground by 10:00 pm and overnight visitors shall leave the campground

by 11:00 am.

- 15. SEASONAL TRAILERS** - Any seasonal trailer entering the campground must be 10 years old or newer. Seasonal trailers can NOT be sold on site regardless of age.
